Fourth of July Block of the month. Adapted from "quilterscache.com" "Go-Along Star \#2." Must be very careful to sew scant $1 / 4$ inch seams.


Cut the Color $14-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 9-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip into two $4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares then stack the squares and cut them once on the diagonal to make four half square triangles.

Now cut the Color $24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
 strip into five $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares... Cut the Color $25-1 / 4$ " square in half on both diagonals to make four quarter square triangles...

Now sew together the Color 1 and Color 3 quarter square triangles in pairs, pressing seams to darker sides. To each of those now-pieced triangles add a Color 1 half square triangle, pressing towards larger triangle. These should measure 4-1/2" (3-1/2")(2-1/2") ...
