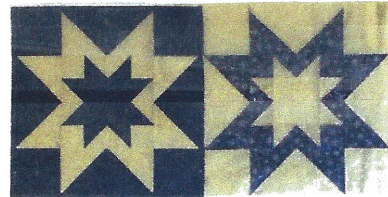


LLQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH DECEMBER 2017



Starflakes

Make either Block A (blue inside star & background & white outer star)

OR

Make Block B (white inside star & background & blue outer star),

OR, MAKE BOTH!

Use 1/4" seams, press to dark. Unfinished block 12 1/2"x 12 1/2".

BLOCK A

<u>Blue Fabrics</u>		<u>Cut</u>	<u>Label</u>
(dark, solid, tone-on-tone,	5	3 1/2" squares	A
or bright, small print)	4	3 1/2x6 1/2" rectangles	B
	8	2" squares	C

<u>White Fabrics</u>		<u>Cut</u>	<u>Label</u>
(bright, solid, tone-on-tone,	8	3 1/2" squares	D
or sparkly/glitter ok)	4	2x3 1/2" rectangles	E
	4	2" squares	F

OR

BLOCK B

<u>White Fabrics</u>		<u>Cut</u>	<u>Label</u>
(bright, solid, tone-on-tone,	5	3 1/2" squares	A
or sparkly/glitter ok)	4	3 1/2x6 1/2" rectangles	B
	8	2" squares	C

<u>Blue Fabrics</u>		<u>Cut</u>	<u>Label</u>
(dark, solid, tone-on-tone,	8	3 1/2" squares	D
or bright, small print)	4	2x3 1/2" rectangles	E
	4	2" squares	F

Sew

Large flying geese units. Use 2 D's & 1 B for each unit. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each D square (refer to diagram). Place D on top of B, right sides together. Sew on line, trim & press. Repeat for other side. Make 4 units. Set aside.

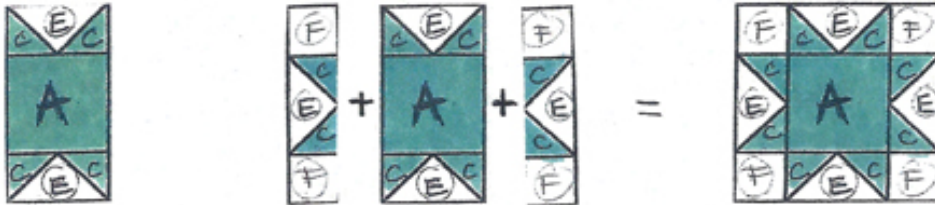


Small flying geese units. Use 2 C's & 1 E for each unit. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each C square. Place C on top of E, right sides together. Sew on line, trim & press. Repeat for the other side. Make 4 units. Set aside.



Assemble (example is Block A)

Start with inner star - Sew smaller flying geese units to 1 A & 4 F's.



Add outer star - sew larger flying geese units to top & bottom of inner star, then add to sides.
