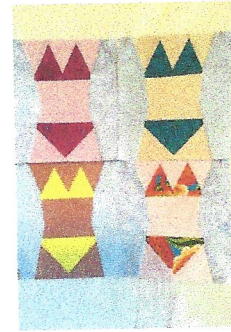


LLQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH

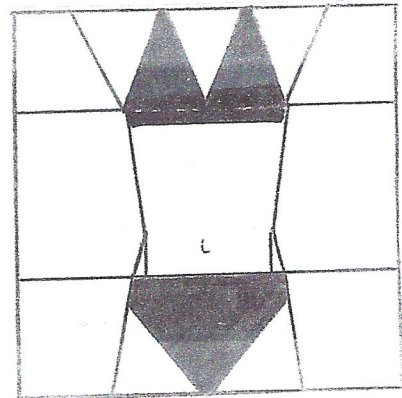
“Sunburn” - original adapted from lenzula@gmx.de. Try your hand at paper piecing!
 Use 1/4” seams/press as you go. Please make one block, measuring 8x8” unfinished.

Fabrics

Background – pale blue sky (clouds ok)
 Bathing Suit – your choice!
 Skin – any flesh color

Assembly (Refer to drawing, use attached pattern)

Prepare Section A (sew 2 to 1)
 Prepare Section B (sew 2 to 1)
 Prepare Section C (sew 2 to 1); then sew A+B+C
 Prepare Section D (sew together in order 1 – 7)
 Prepare Section E (sew together in order 1 – 5)
 Sew D+ABC+E
 Press/trim. Ok to keep the foundation paper on the block.



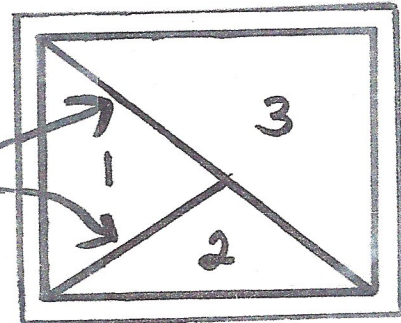
Finishing up

Ok to embellish!!! Add a bellybutton ring/necklace/tattoo?!! Some ideas.....make extras & put the blocks together on sand &/or beach towel print fabric....(Hey no jokes about aftermath of a shark attack or weird water ballet formation).....

Basic Paper Piecing Instructions

Always:

Set stitch length to 12-18 per inch;
 Backstitch at beginning and end of each line
 Sew thru paper exactly on top of stitching line
 Add pieces in order of numbers on paper pattern
 Press – use paper towel to prevent ink transfer
 Trim fabric to 1/4” after adding/stitching each piece



1. Start with piece of fabric large enough to cover #1. Place fabric on back side of paper pattern with **wrong side to paper** (hold to light to check; look thru front of paper). Be sure there is at least 1/4” border. Pin in place.
2. Chose fabric large enough to cover #2 (plus 1/4”). Place #2 piece, right sides together, against #1. Hold in place and flip entire thing over. Stitch on line between #1 & #2. Flip/press/trim seam to 1/4”. Repeat with pieces #3, & so on.....
