*One item per entry form.

*All Judged quilts must have 3 layers and be quilted by hand or machine.

*Entries must be completed within the past 2 years OR never exhibited in a Falling Leaves Quilt Show.

*Quilts MUST have a 3 inch sleeve stitched (basted) to the top of the quilt back, "pinned on" sleeves will **not** be allowed.

*All entries must be clean and free of debris and odor.

*Entries must include the paper label provided. See labeling instructions below.

*KIT QUILTS, TIED QUILTS and ANTIQUE QUILTS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR EXHIBIT ONLY.

*Enter as many items as you wish. Entry Committee will make final decision as to how many will be shown.

*White glove attendants are provided the entire show and every effort will be put forth to protect entrants property.

*Please HONOR YOUR COMMITMENT to get your items to the show on time. If you are unable to show an item you have entered, let us know, ASAP, so we can make a substitution from the waiting list.

FOR JUDGED ENTRIES:

* JUDGED ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE \$6.00 PER ITEM (CHECKS PAYABLE TO LLQG).

* First, Second, and Third place will be awarded in each category – Best of Show and Honorable Mention awards in any category will be at the Judge’s discretion. Judge’s Choice awards may be given.

* Classes with less than 3 entries may or may not be judged.

* Judges comments will be passed on to entrants.

* Judging will be conducted anonymously.

* Judges reserve the right to move an entry to a more appropriate category.

DESCRIPTION OF QUILT STYLE

_____ TRADITIONAL – comprised of recognizable, traditional blocks.

_____ INNOVATIVE - innovative pieced quilt offering a twist on traditional and classic blocks or playing with angles. Techniques can include curves, landscapes, off-kilter versions of traditional blocks, three dimensional piecing, and tessellations. Traditional design elements may be incorporated, but only in an innovative manner that reflects original creativity by the artist.

_____ MIXED TECHNIQUE – two or more dominant techniques including, but not limited to appliqué, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, hand quilting and machine quilting.

JUDGED ITEMS must arrive between 8:00 – 9:30 am

NON-JUDGED ITEMS between 8:00 – 11:00 am

NO ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 11 AM

YOU WILL BE GIVEN A RECEIPT WHEN YOU DROP OFF YOUR ITEMS

2. PICKUP will be Sunday, October 5, 2008 at Lewis Hall from 5:00 – 6:00 pm. NO ENTRY WILL BE RELEASED WITHOUT A RECEIPT! If you arrange for someone else to pick up your items, THEY MUST HAVE YOUR CLAIM RECEIPTS!

LABELING INSTRUCTIONS: Complete first 5 lines of Label (item must have a title). Facing the back side of the quilt, baste label on lower right corner. Baste label on inside bottom of garment and back side of pillow, etc. YOU WILL BE GIVEN A RECEIPT WHEN YOU DROP OFF YOUR ITEMS. FOLD YOUR QUILT SO THAT THE LABEL SHOWS AT DROP OFF.

No entry will be released without your receipt.
