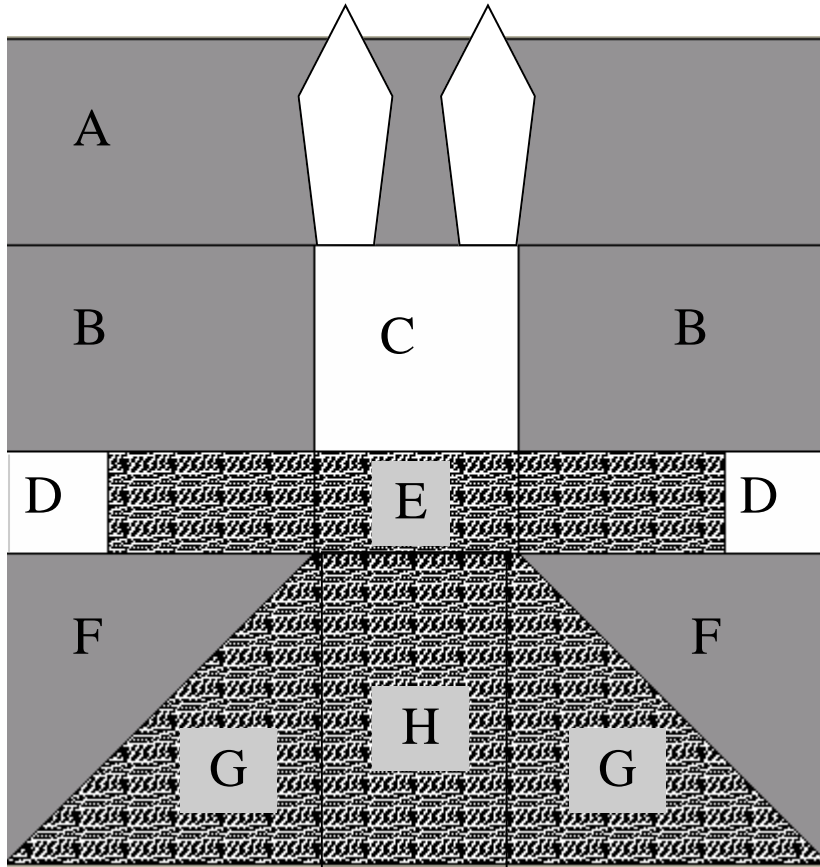
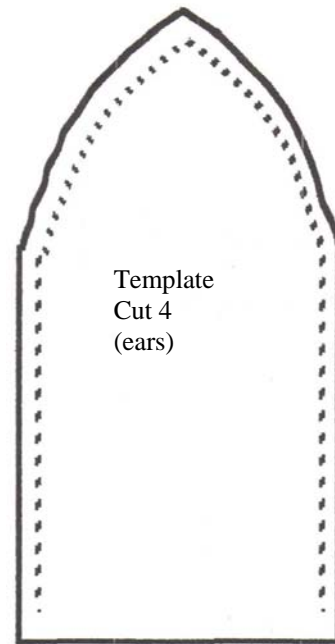


Bunny Hop Quilt Block

7-1/4" Finished block (7-3/4" unfinished)

Bunny Dress:

- E-Cut 1 5-3/4" x 1-1/2" strip
- G-Cut 1 3-7/8" square, then cut diagonal corner to corner
- H-Cut 1 1-3/4" X 3-1/2"

Bunny Face and Hands:

- C-Cut 1 1-3/4" square for head
- D-Cut 2 1-1/2" squares for hands
- Template- Cut 4 Ears

Background:

- A-Cut 1 2-1/2" x 7-3/4"
- B-Cut 2 1-3/4" x 3-1/2"
- G-Cut 1 3-7/8 square, then cut diagonal corner to corner



Sew:

(using 1/4" seam allowance)

- Row 1 (A) is just one strip
- Row 2-Sew B-C-B
- Row 3-Sew D-E-D
- Row 4-Sew F to G then FG-H-FG

Make Ears: Use template to cut out fabric, with right sides together, sew ears on sides but not bottom edge. Clip turn, and press. Make small tuck in each ear and pin over seam at top of head (C).

Sew Row 1 to Row 2 catching ears in the seam. Press toward head to make ears stand up! Continue sewing rows to complete block.

Embellish Bunny as you desire, adding buttons, wiggly eyes, lace, appliqué feet, etc.

I placed sashing around the block using 4 strips 2-7/8" X 7-3/4" with 4 corner stones 2-7/8" square! These could be placed between blocks.
