

Country Store Information

Questions, tags or donation pick up call: Carolyn Dexter at 279-9120

Everyone is encouraged to participate in the country store. It is easy and fun way to make money for yourself and also donate to the guild (80% for you, 20% donation to the guild).

Selling Items:

If you have handmade items, or nice county items or craft recycles to sell, get an inventory sheet and price tags at the membership table or from Carolyn Dexter.

Complete the **Country Store Inventory List** with your name and phone number and a three letter/number code to identify your items. List each different item with the price. For multiple items, at the same price, indicate how many. When pricing items, remember to consider your donation to the guild of 20% .

Attach a tag to each sale item. The tag should have the following information: No. is for your code. Style is for your item number (from the inventory sheet) and size is for a brief description of your item. Price is for what you are asking for the item. **Both parts of the tag must be completed** (this is our inventory control).

Magazines and small items should be bundled so that we have a limited number of items selling for under a \$1.00.

Items for sale by members that are tagged and on an inventory sheet may be brought to the September guild meeting or brought to the fair grounds any time on Friday, October 2, 2009. Be sure to make an extra copy of your inventory sheet as one has to be left with your items.

Donations:

Items that are donations to raise money for the guild (100% goes to the guild) may be brought to any guild meeting and given to Carolyn Dexter for pricing and tagging.

Payment:

Approximately one week after the quilt show you should receive a check from the quilt guild for your sold items.

Return of unsold items:

Sellers should plan to pick up their unsold items at the end of the quilt show on Sunday October 4, 2009. Items that are not picked up will be returned to their owners at the next guild meeting.

Country store staffing:

Members who put items in the country store are encouraged to work a shift in the country store. This is an easy way to participate in the quilt show and a great opportunity to have first view and chance to buy items for sale.
