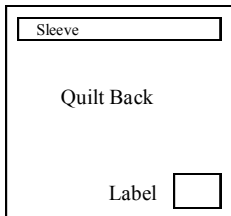

RULES & PROCEDURES

Please Read Carefully

FOR ALL ENTRIES:

1. One item per entry form.
2. All judged quilts must have three (3) layers and be quilted by hand or machine.
3. Entries must be completed within the past 2 years OR never exhibited in a Falling Leaves Quilt Show.
4. Quilts **MUST** have a 3-inch sleeve stitched (basted) to the top of the quilt back, "pinned on" sleeves will not be allowed.
5. All entries must be clean and free of debris and odor.
6. Entries must include the paper label. See labeling instructions provided on pg 2.
7. Kit quilts, tied quilts and antique quilts will be accepted for Exhibit only.
8. Enter as many items as you wish. Entry Committee will make final decision as to how many will be shown.
9. White glove attendants are provided the entire show and every effort will be put forth to protect entrant's property.
10. Please honor your commitment to get your items to the show on time. If you are unable to show an item you have entered, please let us know ASAP so we can make a substitution from the waiting list.
11. Definition of Professional: One who has received payment for machine/hand quilting services or teaches machine/hand quilting.

ALSO FOR JUDGED ENTRIES:

12. Judged entries must include \$6.00 per item. Checks payable to LLQG.
13. First, Second, and Third place will be awarded in each category. Best of Show and Honorable Mention awards in any category will be at the Judge's discretion. Judge's Choice awards may be given.
14. Classes with less than 3 entries may or may not be judged.
15. Judges' comments will be passed on to the entrants.
16. Judging will be conducted anonymously.
17. Judges reserve the right to move an entry to a more appropriate category.

Mail-in Items

1. Quilt must be received by September 20, 2010. Mail to: LLQG, P. O. Box 875, Kelseyville, CA 95451
2. Include a self addressed mailing label and provide USPS return postage in the box when you mail your item. (Hint: keep box open until after purchasing postage.)
3. Call a Show Chairman if you have questions regarding return postage.

Label & Folding Instructions:

1. Complete all 5 lines of the label. **MUST HAVE TITLE**— this is how your quilt is identified.
2. For Quilts: Facing the back side of the quilt, baste label on lower right corner.
3. For other items: Baste label on inside bottom of garment, or on back of pillow, table runner, etc.
4. Fold quilt wrong side out so that the label is prominent.

Entry Drop-Off Instructions

1. Deliver ALL entries on Thursday, Sept. 30, 2010, to Lewis Hall, Lake County Fairgrounds, 401 Martin St. Lakeport, CA.
2. Judged items: Must arrive between 8:00 and 9:30 am (Judging starts promptly thereafter).
3. Exhibit only items: Must arrive between 8:00 and 11:00 am.
4. **NO ITEMS ACCEPTED AFTER THEIR CUT-OFF TIME.**
5. You will be given a receipt for each entry item. Be sure to verify accuracy. Must have a receipt to pick items back up.

Pick-Up Instructions

1. Pick up will be Sunday, October 3, 2010 at Lewis Hall from 5:00 to 6:00 pm.
2. **MUST HAVE A RECEIPT TO PICK UP QUILT.** This is very important.
3. No entries will be released without a receipt. If you arrange for someone else to pick up your items, they must have your claim receipt(s)!
