JUST A FEW LAST MINUTE

LABEL & FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

- Complete label. MUST HAVE TITLE- this is how your quilt is identified.
- For Quilts: Facing the back side of the quilt, <u>baste</u> label on lower right corner.
- For other items: Baste label on inside bottom of garment, or on back of pillow, table runner, etc.
- Fold guilt wrong side out so that the label is prominent.

ENTRY DROP-OFF INSTRUCTIONS

- Deliver ALL entries on Thursday October 4th, 2018, to Frtich Hall, Lake County Fairgrounds, 401 Martin St. Lakeport
- Judged items: Must arrive between 7:30 and 9:30 am (Judging starts promptly thereafter).
- Exhibit only items: Must arrive between 7:30 and 9:30 am
- NO ITEMS ACCEPTED AFTER THEIR CUT-OFF TIME.
- You will be given a receipt for each entry item. Be sure to verify accuracy. Must have a receipt to pick items up. Sun-

Vignettes: Drop off time start at the same as above and closes at 10:00 am!

MEETING MINUTES

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Meeting Minutes, September 8th, 2018 General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Terry Phelps at 10:00 am

Members and Guests: There was one guest, Kahlei Phelps and one new member, Ruth Colaw-Benkelman.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Sandra Redshaw reported an August income of \$1524.40 and expenses of \$2861.21 for a net loss of \$1336.81.

Program: Jane Alameda introduced our speaker Laura Fogg. She will also be our Featured Artist at the Quilt Show next month. Laura lives in Ukiah and is an Art Quilter. She displayed a number of beautiful quilts she has created over the years and talked about techniques used from fabric dying to applique methods and ways of quilting. We will look forward to seeing more of her creations at our Quilt Show.

Upcoming Programs: There will be no meeting in October. The fabric dying class postponed in August will be held the second Sunday in November, the 11th. It will be at Jane Alameda's house. At the November guild meeting we will have several members teaching how to do small projects. The December meeting will be our Christmas Party. Nancy Helldorfer volunteered to organize this party working in conjunction with the Hospitality chairmen Gail Coyle and Barbara Dore. Our speaker for January may be Colleen Granger of Sew Little Time Quilting.

Chairman Reports:

Baby Quilts: Lan Ali-Adeeb reports that we are a little short on the number of blankets needed this month. Kits are available.

Library: Kerry Hansing reminded members that since there is no meeting in October, books rented this month won't be due until the November meeting. There are 3 new books that have been purchased for the library.

Quilt Show: Show Chairman Barbara Haddon announced that there are some \$1 off postcards available in the back of the room. \$1 off coupons are also available on our website. Pre-sale tickets are available for purchase from Cheryl Jones-Murray. They are \$8. During the Quilt Show there will be a make-and-take workstation on the patio. Volunteers are needed to help at this workstation. The next Quilt Show meeting will be at 10:00 am on September 17 at Umpqua Bank in Lakeport. All Show Chairmen must attend. General guild members are encouraged to attend to learn more about the Show. Barbara then did a Power Point presentation for all showing the layout of the fairgrounds, where the buildings are located, where members should park and what workers are required to do and where they are to go to check in. Everyone was reminded that workers do not have to pay admission and there are still a number of opportunities for members to sign up for to work.

• Suzanne Hoyt said there are signs and banners available for members to pick up to advertise the Show. Banners must be signed out. Everything should be returned at the November guild meeting.

Shirley announced she will not be in charge of setup and take-down next year. She needs someone who will work with her this year that can take over this position next year.

Suzanne Lee still has some fliers and bookmarks available for members to distribute to advertise the Show.

Shery Loewen needs more volunteers to do White Glove during the show, especially since the Show is in two buildings.

Nancy Helldorfer reports there are 10 vendors for the Show. Some will be located in each building. A highlight will be a vendor from Hawaii, Quilt Passions.

Marj Sweeney needs a few more volunteers on Sunday for quilt hanging and takedown and quilt folding.

Betty Fessler recognized all the guild members who signed up and worked at the Lake County Fair helping with the Opportunity Quilt ticket sales and monitoring the building where quilts are displayed at the fair. She has cellophane available for Theme Baskets. These baskets will be located in the Little Theater. Betty needs workers both at the Kelseyville Pear Festival and at the Quilt Show to work at the Op Quilt table and at the Theme Basket table. Betty is also in charge of story pinning for the Show and needs workers to help with this. At this point we don't know if our Op Quilt will be displayed at PIQF. It is on a waitlist.

Connie Cracraft said there will be two new judges at the Show. Judging requires two types of workers; some scribes and some to manage the quilts for the judges. This is a great experience to learn what judges look for in judging the quilts.

Barbara Mahoney needs more items to be donated for the Silent Auction. She urged everyone to call her if they have donations.

Treasurer Sandra Redshaw announced that all items for sale in the Country Store must be in whole dollar amounts.

Terry Phelps needs a few more workers for quilt drop-off and pick-up. Times are Friday from 7:30 – 9:30 am and Sunday from 4:30 to approximately 6:00 pm.
