Marj Sweeney provided the recipe for her Nutty Broccoli Slaw that was so popular at a recent meeting.

**Marj's Nutty Broccoli Slaw**

Ingredients: 1 package (3 oz.) Chicken Ramen Noodles  
1 package (16 oz.) Broccoli Slaw Mix (Found mine at Safeway)  
2 cups sliced green onions (about 2 bunches)  
1 + ½ cups broccoli florets  
1 can (6 oz.) ripe olives, drained and halved  
1 cup slivered almonds, toasted  
½ cup sugar ½ cup cider vinegar  
½ cup olive oil

Directions: 1. Set aside the noodle seasoning packet; crush the noodles and place in a large bowl. Add the slaw mix, onions, broccoli, olives, sunflower kernels and almonds. 2. In a jar with a tight-fitting lid, combine the sugar, vinegar, oil and contents of seasoning packet; shake well. Drizzle over salad and toss to coat. Serve immediately.
