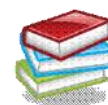
Class on Sunday: A Pre-cut party.... Students can bring their own pre-cuts and an idea or Colleen has several patterns designed to use with various sizes.


