Marjan's presentation "Creative Exploration" is a humorous and educational slide lecture with a trunk show. You will learn about her untraditional approach to quilting and how she creates her hand dyed fabrics.



Sunday Workshop: Dyed Fabrics: They're ir-rest-able: Learn to create your own beautiful hand-dyed fabrics! You will become familiar with the principles of color theory, fabric dyeing using Procion fiber reactive dyes, and many surface design techniques such as immersion dyeing to create color progressions or value gradations; dye painting; bleach discharge; resist techniques; shibori; stamping and stenciling.

A few spots are still open for the dyeing workshop. We want to fill our classes, if we fall short of member sign-ups, the class will be offered to quilters outside our guild !

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Meeting Minutes, July 14th 2018

General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Terry Phelps at 10:00 am

Members and Guests: There were no guests or new members.

Treasurer Report: There was no treasurer report as Treasurer Sandra Redshaw was not present.

Program: Jane Alameda introduced our speaker Arlene Arnold from Heritage Oaks Quilts in Colusa with her presentation "Stitches of Glory". Arlene was dressed in costume of the period and we enjoyed seeing and touching, a large number of antique quilts & tops dating from 1830 - 1890. She provided a narrative which were excerpts from her great grandmother's journal as she traveled from Ohio to California.

Upcoming Programs:

In August there will be a class held at Jane's house where attendees will create their own hand-dyed fabrics.

Chairman Reports:

Quilt Show:

Gretchen Moore has forms available for Country Store items. They will also be available on our website. She has a sign-up sheet for workers.

Betty Fessler has baskets, ribbon and wrapping in the back of the room for Theme Baskets. Basket #1 has been changed from 'Books' to 'Dogs'.
