


Ways & Means (Lake Works) — Gail Coyle

MEETING MINUTES

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes, July 13, 2019 General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Terry Phelps at 10:02

Members and Guests: There were 58 guild members present and 4 guests: Sharon Burger, Riley Brose, Julie Sahf and Carolyn Kananen

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Kitty Jones reported that there was an income of \$536.00 with expenses of \$1,240.32 for a net loss of \$704.32 for the month of June.

Program: Jane Alameda introduced our guest speaker Marie Strait with her trunk show displaying examples of her 35 year quilting journey. Tomorrow guild member Linda Morrison will teach a class on making a quilt and tote from old jeans. The class will meet at the Scotts Valley Women's Center. Attendees should arrive at 9:30 with the class starting at 10:00 am.

Upcoming Programs:

August: Scarlet Rose will be the guest speaker with her lecture "A View from Both Sides - Quilt Competition and Judging". There will be no class in August however there can be a workshop after the guild meeting if needed to work on quilts for the show.

January: Lisa McKissick will again be our speaker.

February: Linda Ballard will be speaking and will be teaching a class on Sunday. Jane has a book of all the classes she offers. She may offer two different patterns to be taught in the class. The first 10 to sign up for the class get to decide what patterns will be taught in the class.

Hospitality: the sign-up sheet is being passed around the room for next month's meeting. **Ways and Means:** Chairman Gail Coyle announced that the guild income from items sold at LakeWorks was \$36 for last quarter.

Quilt Show: Linda Morrison substituted for Chairman Barbara Haddon who is out of town. Several show chairmen made announcements. Sign-up sheets for volunteers for all areas are in the back of the meeting room. There are 84 days left until the show. She showed a few examples of art and modern quilts and will have more at the next guild meeting so entries can be categorized appropriately.

Shery Loewen needs volunteers to perform white glove duties in both buildings.

Cheri Lowe announced that there will be only one Welcome Table. It will be located outside between the two buildings under a tent. She will need volunteers to man the entrance to each building to check for wrist bands.

Country Store sign-ups are needed. Gretchen will have supplies available at the next guild meeting for members who want to sell items.

Sue Schedler needs a couple of volunteers to man booths for vendors during demos or any breaks they may need.

Betty Fessler announced that there is a new Theme Basket provided by Cindy Martelle with the theme of "Dogs".

Dottie Kauffman needs volunteers to work at the County Fair to sell tickets for the Op Ouilt.

Suzanne Lee will have a camera at the August guild meeting to take pictures of quilts being entered in the show. She also needs guild members to sign up to deliver flyers and bookmarks to quilt shops around the north state. The list of shops and flyers/bookmarks are at the back of the room. Suzanne also announced that she will no longer be the Publicity Chairman. A new chairman is needed for next year. Suzanne will be happy to mentor someone.

Suzanne Holt has signs available in the back of the room for members to post around the county to advertise the show.

Marion Onstad and Rachel Heher have pre-sale tickets available. They are \$8 instead of \$10, the price at the door.

Susanne Scholz will be in charge of quilt check-in and check-out and needs volunteers. Some positions are sit-down and others require carrying quilts to and from the tables.

Barbara Dore' has had 15 entries turned in so far for Vignettes. She has the capability to have at least 30. She has entry forms available both here at the meeting and online.

Marj Sweeney is in charge of quilt hanging and takedown. She needs volunteers to help with this and also to fold quilts once they have been taken down.
