Summer theme items will sell at Lake Works. Small items are popular—pot holders, bibs, placemats, etc. Thank you to all who brought items last month.



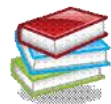

MEETING MINUTES

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes, June 8, 2019

General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Terry Phelps at 10:02 am

Members and Guests: One guest was welcomed, Bonnie Riley. There were 57 guild members in attendance.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Kitty Jones reported an income of \$2343.50 for May with expenses of \$403.02 for a net income of \$1940.48. A large portion of the income, \$1912.50, was from the guild fabric and book sale during the May meeting.

Chairman Reports:

Hospitality Chair Gail Coyle is passing around the sign-up sheet for the June

Ways and Means: Gail also showed some potholders made by Barbara Haddon that have been made for selling at LakeWorks. She also has some projects that are available for someone to make. Please see her to pick up one of these projects.

Quilt Show Chairman Barbara Haddon reports that the first entry forms have been turned in for our upcoming Quilt Show. Entry forms are available at today's meeting and are also available on our website. All entry forms must be turned in by our August 10 guild meeting. Suzanne Lee will have a camera available at the July meeting if anyone needs to have a picture taken of a quilt entry. Barbara also reports that all chairman positions have now been filled. Leanne Harvey has volunteered to chair the Cleanup-final position. Barbara stresses that volunteers are needed for all committees. Sign-up sheets will be available at the July guild meeting. White Glove Chairman Shery Loewen described what this committee does and stressed that she needs enough volunteers to be available in both buildings during the show. Linda Morrison will head up the frame setup and takedown. Pam Fiora's husband will lead the setup/takedown crew but more help is needed. The Little Theater setup is done on Thursday and Fritch Hall setup will be on Friday. Takedown starts after the show closes at 4 pm on Sunday. Theme Basket Chairman Betty Fessler has some baskets available here today if any group needs one. The next Quilt Show meeting is on June 17 at 1 am at Umpqua Bank, Lakeport. All guild members may attend this meeting.

Baby Quilts: Chairman Lan Ali-Adeeb announced that there are kits available with holiday themed fabrics including 4th of July and Christmas. She handed out several kits.

Program: Jane Alameda introduced Angie Thornton with her trunk show and talk on a myriad of stories of her quilting journey. There will be a class on Sunday where Angie will guide attendees in how to make a Jelly Roll Rug.

Upcoming Programs:

July: Our speaker will be Marie Strait with her lecture that will take us on a journey of her 35 years of quilting, from traditional quilts, made before rotary cutters, to art quilts made from fused fabric. There will be a class on Sunday with guild member Linda Morrison teaching how to make a Denim (Jeans) Quilt and a Bag to store the quilt. The supply list is available for those signed up to attend.

BOARD MEETING

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order by President Terry Phelps at 12:40 pm

Call to Order: President Terry Phelps called the meeting to order at 12:25 pm.

Present: Terry Phelps, Jane Alameda, Kitty Jones, Kathy Pratt, Marj Sweeney, Linda Morrison, Betty Fessler and Barbara Haddon.

Old Business: There was no old business.

New Business:

Marj Sweeney made a request that the New Quilter Theme Basket at the Quilt Show should contain the gift of a one-year free membership for Ladies of the Lake Quilt Guild. This membership offer would be valid for a 2-year window. The Board approved this request.

Quilt Show:

Barbara Haddon will be responsible to collect large amounts of money from Quilt Show Chairmen on Saturday afternoon and will instruct each Chairman to be in charge of their cashbox over night on Saturday. Treasurer Kitty Jones will distribute the boxes to each Chairman Saturday morning and pick them up at the end of the day on Sunday.

Pre-Sale tickets will be available at a few locations. Barbara will discuss the management of these tickets at the upcoming Quilt Show meeting on June 17.

Disaster Relief Quilts: Betty said that some quilts turned in are too small to qualify. These small quilts will be completed if needed then put into LakeWorks to be sold. The Board discussed where the Disaster Relief quilts will be stored since Kerrie's Quilt Shop is now closed. A possible option is the Upper Lake Fire Department. Terry will check into this. A form needs to be created to be kept at the quilt distribution location to record information about the recipient of each quilt.

Meeting Location: The Guild signs a contract annually to rent the Lakeport Senior Citizens Center at a cost of \$250/month. The Board discussed whether to continue to use this location or look at what other locations may be available and their cost.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:20 pm
