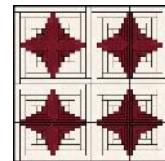
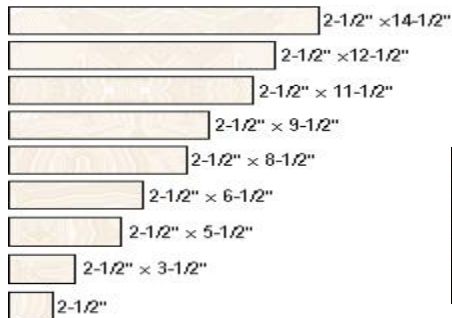
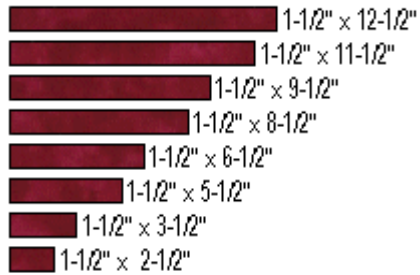


Sew & Tell News

Block of the Month— Christy Bengston

The May block is called : **Log Cabin Star**— Please use Red & White Fabric for 14" block

Red—Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" by width of fabric sub-cut White—Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" by width of fabric



Working clockwise around the center (Color 2 2-1/2") square, with a consistently accurate 1/4" seam, first add a Color 1 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" strip. Press out the seam and add the next longest Color 1 strip (3-1/2") to the bottom of that. Press out the seam and add the shortest Color 2 strip (3-1/2") to the left side. Press out that seam and add the next longest Color 2 strip to the top. Press that out and add the next longest Color 1 strip to the right side....and continue in this manner, adding longer and longer strips clockwise 'til all strips have been added. Design via Quilters Cache.com

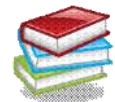

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Meeting Minutes, April 13, 2019

General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Terry Phelps at 10:03 a.m.

Members and Guests: We welcomed 2 guests: Mary Jones and Christy Barnes. There were 59 members present today.

Thank You: Terry read a very nice & moving thank you note from Nancy Teal, a Paradise Fire Survivor.

Website: Pam Fiora is our new Web Editor. Items for the web should be given to her. Please be patient while she is learning how to do the editing.

Op Quilt 2020: Terry announced that the Opportunity Quilt Committee for 2020 would meet after the meeting with Jane Alameda.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Kitty Jones reported that for the month of March we brought in \$445 from Quilt Show Vendor fees, \$100 in dues, \$180 from the Opportunity Quilt, and \$177 from the Treasure Chest raffle, all income totaling \$902. Expenses totaled \$649.78 for a net gain of \$252.22

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Call to Order: Terry Phelps, President, called the meeting to order at 12:55 p.m.

Present: Terry Phelps, Jane Alameda, Linda Morrison, Marj Sweeney, Dottie Kauffman, Shirley Viada, Rebecca Scroggins, and Kitty Jones.

Old Business:

Audit Committee Update: Kitty Jones reported that she, Kathy Pratt, and Jane Alameda met to conduct the audit of 2018. One month was selected at random and gone through. No errors were found. Kathy Pratt wrote this up and it will be filed in the 2019 binder.

Wireless Mic Setup Update: Terry Phelps reported that the new mic setup (which will cost \$325 - \$375) may not be compatible with our current amp. An additional \$225 - \$250 may be needed for a new amp. It was agreed that it would be OK to go over the \$500 already allocated for this item. We will need the new unit to be able to cover the 2 building at the quilt show. We will still be able to use our old unit for other things as needed. Terry will know by next month.

New Business:

Baby Quilt Labels: Terry will find out if "Loving" (should be "Lovingly") is a typo. We also need to check the minutes to see what was agreed to previously. Terry thought that approval was given to do the new label & that the Community Service existing budget would pay for it.

Logistics: Marj expressed concern over the extra time taken for the Program to show items specially for the Board and Treasure Chest tables. We need to move into the main audience so as to provide a smoother flow for the quilts being shown. Also, it would be helpful to get to the program sooner. We started the program at 10:20 today. Terry will try to cut 5 minutes off

Disaster Relief Quilts: Rebecca Scroggins volunteered to keep these quilts once Kerrie's shop closes at the end of the month. It was determined that we need to talk with Kerrie to find out how it has been done in the past in order to determine how we will do it. We know we'll need to keep a log and require proof of loss before handing anything out. We will invite Kerrie to the next Board Meeting

Meeting was adjourned at 1:28.
