Block of the Month — Carol Corwin-Weiss

How about something new gals !

While we are not meeting, I'll post traditional blocks to sew and you can use your fabric stashes and imagination to complete the blocks. When we meet again in person please have your blocks stitched together for a (?) placemat, table topper, baby quilt or whatever size you choose. (Baby quilt size would be delightful!)



You may make your blocks any size you prefer as well as choose your own color combinations each month. The block shown is known as a Rail Fence or by Quilters Cache as "Four Part Strip Block". I used the Quilters Cache instructions, do a search on their site using the quilt block name.
