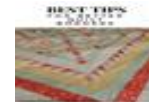

IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Unfortunately, the quilt show has been cancelled for this year.

A number of things were taken into account in making this decision: The current health issues that we are all dealing with; the fact that two thirds of the committee chairpersons were in favor of canceling; that even if we did have the show how many people would actually attend. This was presented to the board members and they agreed that we should cancel. I have spoken to the fairgrounds and we will be getting our deposit back as well as a new contract for next year with no deposit due until early next year.

Having said all of this I must tell you that the fairgrounds is in trouble. They need our help because we may not have a fairgrounds by next year. We need to contact our legislators (Mike McGuire, senator.mcguire@senate.ca.gov and Cecilia M. Aguiar-Curry, P.O. Box 942849, Sacramento, CA 94249) letting them know that we do not want to lose the fairgrounds. PLEASE consider writing or calling as our County needs to save our Fairgrounds. Currently the fairgrounds is applying for grants as well as other ways to bring in money, but they are short. Any help or ideas would be appreciated.
