Put simply, magic fabrics give a quilt light and life. Some suggest light coming from below the surface (luminosity) or bouncing across the surface (luster). Others imply that see-through colors overlap to create new color mixtures (transparency).



What constitutes a magic fabric? I describe many as “shot with light.” They usually display variations in value—light areas among darker areas, or light-to-dark gradations—and they typically contain warm colors. Batiks, hand-dyes, and hand-painted fabrics have a dappled quality; some commercial fabrics appear to “smolder,” an illusion that lends depth and warmth to even the simplest quilts.

### IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Unfortunately, the quilt show has been cancelled for this year.

A number of things were taken into account in making this decision: The current health issues that we are all dealing with; the fact that two thirds of the committee chairpersons were in favor of canceling; that even if we did have the show how many people would actually attend. This was presented to the board members and they agreed that we should cancel. I have spoken to the fairgrounds and we will be getting our deposit back as well as a new contract for next year with no deposit due until early next year.

Currently the fairgrounds is applying for grants as well as other ways to bring in money, but they are short. Any help or ideas would be appreciated.
