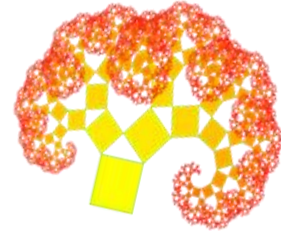

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Meeting Minutes, August 14th, 2018

General Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Jane Alameda at 10:05.

Members and Guests: There are two visitors, Barbara Stock and Judi Murray. There is one new member, Ann Polk.

Treasurer Report: Treasurer Sandra Redshaw reported an income of \$44.40 and expenses of \$1,702.05 for a net loss of \$1,657.65 for the month of July.

Announcements: President Terry Phelps is not here as she has evacuated due to the Ranch Fire.

Nominating Committee is needed for officers for 2019. Two Board members are needed as well as 3 from the general membership. This committee needs to meet and supply a list of candidates at the September Guild meeting. Volunteers are: Linda Morrison, Marj Sweeney, Pat Dandy, Suzanne Lee.

Scholarship Program for PIQF attendance. Forms are available for members to pick up.

Program: Jane Alameda introduced our speaker Marjn Kluepfel with her talk "Creative Exploration". Marjn is an art quilter and fabric dyer. She presented a trunk show of many beautiful quilts showing her progression over the years in these arts.

The fabric dying class scheduled for tomorrow has been postponed due to the wildfires in the area.

Quilt Show:

Chairman Barbara Haddon announced that the deadline for quilt entries will be extended one week. If anyone needs longer they are to contact Barbara. 
