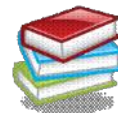
Treasure Chest—Linda Wankel & Kerry Lopez

Programs—Kerry Hansing

July Program – Diane Goldsmith Harger

Saturday, July 8th. We will Host Diane Goldsmith Harger. Diane’s history with quilting is heavily influenced by her study of Japanese textile arts. Her pieces feature fabrics she hand dyes using Shibori, Indigo, and other dyeing techniques including ice dyeing. However, she is particularly known for the pleating, tucking, and hand smocking techniques she uses to create the fabric manipulation she incorporates into her work.

Diane will present her trunk show elaborating on the different techniques she used to create her quilts.

Directly After The Meeting Diane will teach us how to make the kanzashi flowers sewn onto the buckram in the photos and the origami folded flowers made from circles of fabric and finished on both the front and back. The fee for this class is a bargain at \$25. We have reserved the center for Saturday afternoon, please take advantage of this special day. You may contact Kerry via email if you decide to join the class, we have lots of room at the Senior Center. No sewing machines required for the class.

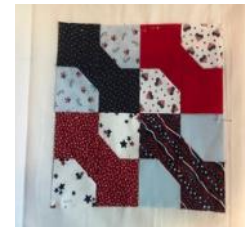
If you look at the samples ...the kanzashi flowers are sewn onto the buckram. The origami folded flowers are made from circles of fabric and are finished on both the front and back. These are lots of fun to make—and easy too ! Embellish your quilts with these beautiful flowers ! **There is simple homework to be completed, Don’t forget to make your circles & squares in advance !**

Ladies of the Lake Quilt Guild BOARD Meeting: June 10, 2017

Called to order by President Betty Fessler at 12:40 pm

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

OLD BUSINESS: Discussion on whether or not to use MyGrove as our 'webmaster' and or use their calendar and blogging option. Sandra and Kerry will try the site once Betty adds their names to it. We will then discuss at July meeting. Weebly currently charges \$49/year and the board has not heard from Christy if that account is current; we will need an invoice before the Treasurer can pay. Further discussion tabled until the July meeting.

There was a brief discussion about which submissions to the Sew-n-Tell need to be submitted to the board prior to publication. Again, Betty will gather more input and discussion will continue at the next meeting (July)

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 package (8 ½ OZ.) corn bread/muffin mix
- 1 can (4 oz.) chopped green chilies, undrained
- 1/8 tsp ground cumin
- 1/8 tsp dried oregano
- Pinch rubbed sage

- 1 cup mayonnaise
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 envelope ranch salad dressing mix

- 2 cans (15 oz. each) pinto beans, rinsed and drained
- 2 cans (15 ¼ oz. each) whole kernel corn, drained
- 3 medium tomatoes, chopped
- 1 cup chopped green pepper
- 1 cup chopped green onions
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese

DIRECTIONS:

1. Prepare corn bread batter according to package directions. Stir in chilies, cumin, oregano and sage. Spread in a greased 8 – inch square baking pan. Bake at 400 degrees for 20 -25 minutes or until a toothpick inserted near the center comes out clean. Cool.
2. In a small bowl, combine mayonnaise, sour cream and dressing mix; set aside.
3. Crumble half of the corn bread into a 13 x 9 in. dish. Place dollops of half of the mayonnaise mixture on corn bread. Layer with half of the beans, corn, tomatoes, green pepper, onions mixture. Place half of the cheese next. Repeat layers (dish will be very full). Cover and refrigerate for 2 hours. Yield: 12 servings.
