This “Friendship Block” pattern came from a Napa Valley Quilters retreat block exchange. Endless possibilities...great for quick baby quilts or “slice and dice” and rearrange the blocks for a different look... try using the blocks for a colorful border...

- ¼ inch seams
- Press seams to the darker fabric

PLEASE MAKE 4 SEPARATE 6 1/2inch BLOCKS!

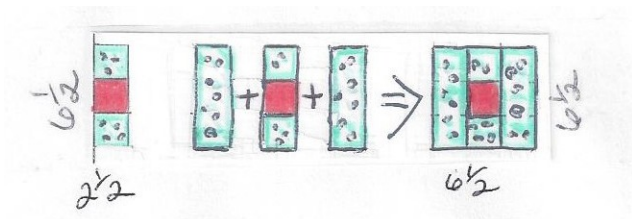
Fabrics – your color choice

- 2 ½ inch strips with dots, circles, or polka dots
- 2 ½ inch strips contrasting solids (for center squares)

For each block cut –

- 2 2 ½ x 6 ½ inch (dots)
- 2 2 ½ inch squares (dots)
- 1 2 ½ inch square (solid)

Sew – (to make one block)



PLEASE MAKE 4 SEPARATE BLOCKS 6 ½ inch x 6 ½ inch unfinished

(They can be identical or 4 different colors)
