
## LLQG BLOCK OF THE MONTH MAY 2017

"Wild Spring Poppies" are everywhere! This block is 8 ½ inches, unfinished. Please use ¼ inch seams, and press towards the darker fabric.

<u>Fabrics</u> – Pick your favorite poppy petal color – pink, red, orange, or yellow. White tone-on-tone for the background, and bright yellow or black for the center.

**Cutting and Prep** 

\*note - drawings not to scale\*

Petals – 2 lights and 2 darks (ex: 2 light pinks, and 2 dark pinks)

Cut 1 4 7/8inch square of each color (ex: 4 squares, each a different shade of pink)

Prep – draw a diagonal line corner-to-corner, on the wrong side of the two lighter squares

Background - white tone-on-tone

Cut 4 2 ½ inch squares

"B"

Prep – on the wrong side of each square, draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner

Flower Center - bright yellow or black

Cut 4

1 1/2 inch squares

"C"

Prep – on the wrong side of each square, draw a diagonal line, corner-to-corner

<u>Sew</u> \*IMPORTANT to follow orientation of pieces in diagrams during construction\*

1) Petals – place a light square on top of a dark square, right sides together. Stitch ¼ inch on either side of the diagonal line. Repeat. Cut on solid line. Press. Makes 4 units.




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






2) Add background – place marked background square, right side down, on upper left corner of each poppy petal half-square-triangle unit. Stitch on the line. Trim. Press. Repeat, making 4 units.





3) Add center - place marked center square, right side down on lower right corner (see diagram).

Stitch on the line. Trim. Press. Repeat, making 4 units.
