

2017 Guild Challenge—Are you ready for some extra fun?

Mystery Quilt - Shirley Liskey

CLUE #1

Cut four (4) 2 x 42 inch strips of medium color fabric; Cut four (4) 2 x 42 inch strip of dark fabric

Sew med/dark strips right sides together to make 4 strip sets

Sub-cut strip sets into 2 inch sections; Sew 64-2 in sections to make 32 four patch units

With background fabric and a medium/light fabric cut Thirteen (13) 2 x42 inch BG (background) fabric

Thirteen (13) 2 x 42 inch strips of med fabric make 13 strip set. Sub-cut strip sets into 256 2 inch sections

Make 128 four patch units
