Crazy Quilt [to be sold at LakeWorks or other venue]



GUIDELINES

- 7" x 7" block
- work on muslin base
- crazy -- no right angles or parallel lines
- use at least 5 fabrics
- jewel tones: amber, amethyst, ruby, emerald, etc
- may use lace, satin, velvet, silk -- does not need to be washable
- at least 1 embroidered patch (may be cut from preembroidered cloth)
- at least 1 decorated seam (may be machine sewn)
- embellish with sequins, beads, lace, ribbon, charms, etc
- turn in squares in March & April Guild meetings

- Muslin square (greater than 7" square if you're going to hoop it to embroider)

- Heavy duty extension cord
- Lunch
