**RULES AND PROCEDURES
FALLING LEAVES QUILT SHOW
OCTOBER 4 & 5, 2025**

1. One item per entry form. **DEADLINE FOR ENTRY FORM IS AUGUST 10, 2025.**
2. All *judged* quilts must have three (3) layers that define a quilt (top, batting, backing + quilting).
3. Entries must never have been previously exhibited in a Falling Leaves Quilt Show.
4. Quilts must have a minimum 3 inch sleeve stitched to the top back – **pinned on sleeves will not be allowed.**
5. All entries must be clean and free of debris and odor.
6. Entries must include the paper label basted to the back lower right corner – see label example on next page.
7. **Purchased** quilts, **Tied** quilts, and **Antique** quilts will be **accepted for NON-JUDGED exhibit only.**
8. Enter as many items as you wish; entry committee will make final decision as to how many will be shown based on how much space is available.
9. Please honor your commitment to get your items to the show on time. If you need to pull your item, let us know no later than September 26, 2025, so that we can make a substitution from the waiting list.
10. JUDGED entries must include \$10.00 per item. NON-Judged quilts must include \$3.00 per item. NON-Judged Vignettes must incl. \$1.00 per item. Make checks payable to LLQG.
All fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
11. Judging Committee and Judges reserve the right to move an entry to a different category as needed.
12. First, Second and Third place ribbons may be awarded in each category. Best of Show, Best of Category, Judge's Choice and Honorable Mention ribbons will be at the judge's discretion. Specialty Ribbons incl. Best hand quilting, hand piecing, hand embellishment and mach. quilting by maker (non pro) may be awarded.
13. Judge's comments will be passed on to the entrant. Judging will be conducted anonymously.
14. VIEWERS CHOICE – as voted by the show attendees, will be awarded \$50.00.
15. Kit – Pre-packaged, commercially sold pattern & fabrics or month-by-month pattern and fabrics. Preselected fabrics comprise 50% or more of quilt. (Not eligible for Best of Show, Specialty or Judges Choice ribbons.)

MAIL IN ENTRY ITEMS – must be received by **October 1, 2025**. Mail to: **LLQG, Box 875, Kelseyville, CA 95451**. Include a self-addressed return mailing label and provide USPS return postage in the box with your item. Call the Quilt Show Chairman with any questions.

ENTRY DROP-OFF INSTRUCTIONS

Deliver **ALL** entries on **Thursday, October 2, 2025**, to Lewis Hall, Lake County Fairgrounds, 401 Martin St., Lakeport, CA, **between 8:00am and 9:30am.**

NO ITEMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE CUT-OFF TIME.

You will be given a receipt for each entry item; please verify accuracy. **MUST HAVE EACH RECEIPT TO PICK UP EACH ENTRY. NO ENTRY WILL BE RELEASED WITHOUT A RECEIPT.**

FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS – fold quilt wrong side out so that label is prominent.

ALL QUILTS MUST HAVE A MINIMUM 3", SEWN IN SLEEVE & LABEL TO BE ACCEPTED.

PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS

Sunday, October 5, 2025, at Lewis Hall from **5:30pm until 6:30pm. MUST HAVE RECEIPTS.** NO ENTRY WILL BE RELEASED WITHOUT A RECEIPT.

CATEGORIES

ART QUILTS – must be original or original interpretations of form and composition, produced with creativity. They must step beyond tradition in appearance. May include media other than fabric.

ART, ABSTRACT - quilts must be original with emphasis on color, line and design.

ART, PICTORIAL/ NATURESCAPE – must illustrate a recognizable image such as natural scenery, wildlife, cityscape, people, etc.

INNOVATIVE QUILTS - twist on traditional and classic blocks or playing with angles. Techniques can include curves, landscapes, off-kilter versions of traditional blocks, 3-D piecing and tessellations. Traditional design elements may be incorporated, but only in an innovative manner that reflects original creativity.

MODERN QUILT – should reflect the modern esthetic. Should use improvisational piecing techniques or be set with large amounts of negative space including alternative grid work and abstract design.

DEFINITIONS:

GROUP– made by 4 or more people such as Round Robin, Block of Month, Opportunity Quilt, etc_

YOUTH– made by quilter 17 yrs. or under.

TRADITIONAL QUILTS - should be based on traditional patterns and settings.

TRADITIONAL, PIECED - should be mainly pieced

TRADITIONAL, APPLIQUÉ - should be mainly Appliqué

OTHER QUILTS - includes wholecloth, stenciled, stamped, painted, embroidery, crazy, pleated, etc.

MINIATURE - must be **to scale**, overall pattern or wholecloth, perimeter not more than 96 inches total.

VIGNETTE - (must include fabric / needle work)

WEARABLE – must have some quilting.

HOME DÉCOR - pillow, table runner, placemats, toys, holiday décor, tree skirts, ornaments, etc.

LABEL – Complete both lines of label. **MUST** have title. **BASTE label to back side of quilt - lower right corner**. For other items, baste label to inside bottom of garment or on back of pillow, table runner, etc.

**Placement of sleeve and label –
Must be sewn in.**
