

BINDING A QUILT USING THE BACKING FABRIC BROUGHT TO THE FRONT - CREATING MITERED CORNERS

1. After quilting the entire quilt....
2. Cut away the batting even with the quilt top, use scissors, be very careful to **not cut the backing fabric.**
3. Lay the backing out away from the quilt top, trim to 1" from the quilt edge-rotary cut is OK, this 1" becomes the binding.
4. Start at a corner, fold the binding as per the diagrams. Pin all corners before stitching.
Stitch on front of the quilt along the edge of the binding. Straight stitch or fancy stitch---your choice.
